- (ii) Mention and briefly describe tools used by Quantity Surveyor when performing his/her professional activities
- (iii) Mention three Universities that train Architecture and Quantity Surveying.
- (iv) Mention two allied professions to Architecture
- (v)Mention two allied professions to Quantity Surveying.

Essay must be written in either English or Kiswahili; Students are free to consult any person for assistance. Further the Essay must be hand written(not typed) in the maximum of three pages paper size centimetre 21 x 30('A4 size'
